

FUSA-HCC BOT Bargaining Meeting
April 11, 2007
1:25 p.m.

In attendance were the administrative team members: Mark Levitt, Craig Johnson, Sue Flaig, Carlos Soto, Karen Griffin, and Donna Miller. FUSA bargaining team: Michael Moats, Eric Joost, Maribeth Mobley, Kimberly Williams; and Ed Mitchell representing UFF.

The administration stated that FUSA had not submitted faculty names for the form compilation activity as discussed at the last bargaining session. FUSA stated that administration's response by email that members of the FUSA bargaining team could not serve on the committee, the inclusion of administrators other than academic deans, and increasing the size of the committee was not what FUSA agreed to. FUSA submitted a completed compiled form for the administration to consider.

FUSA proposed language for 5.3 to address the email use issue. Sue Flaig agreed to talk with IT about the language.

FUSA submitted Article 1 and 2.6, correcting the names of the bargaining affiliates.

FUSA submitted 8.16, changing language to strengthen the class disruption procedure.

FUSA submitted 12.7, changing language to specify the length of time the faculty member must work upon return from sabbatical.

The administration submitted the following proposals, cleaning up and correcting typos: 6.17, 8.22, 11.1, 12.1, and 12.2.

The administration submitted 12.11, eliminating much of the article so that it refers to USERRA regulations, which change periodically. The intent is that the administration will adhere to USERRA.

The administration submitted 13.4 to reflect a change in practice and 13.6 to clarify language.

The administration and FUSA tentatively agreed (TA'd) to 1, 2.6, 8.16, 8.22, 11.1, 12.1, 12.2, 13.4, and 13.6.

The administration submitted 6.6 to change the method of posting vacancies and time frame for application.

The administration said they were still reviewing FUSA's proposals on 6.16 and article 9 submitted at two weeks ago.

The next meeting was scheduled for Monday, April 30, 2-5 p.m., Dale Mabry.
