

FUSA-HCC BOT Bargaining Meeting
June 22, 2007

Article 6.18 – FUSA’s revised proposal was TA’d after some omitted words were added.

Article 8.2.C.1.b. Administration’s proposal of changing the job title to Director of Academic Technology was TA’d.

Consensus to add the words “by appointment” to 8.6.G. of the administration’s proposal.

FUSA proposed changes to 6.23, to ensure that retired faculty members “shall” have certain privileges including the ability to checkout library materials. The administrative team agreed. FUSA also asked that retired faculty maintain email access for a period of time after retirement to facilitate communication. Discussions of time periods from six months to one year resulted in the administration stating they would have to discuss the proposal with the OIT.

The administration proposed changes to Article 8.4.D.3.a and b removing the word “tenured” and thereby allowing providing all full-time faculty priority over all adjunct faculty in assignment of certain overloads. FUSA countered that the current language takes into account that tenured faculty have been through several significant evaluations that justify their priority over adjunct faculty and that non-tenured faculty may not have been evaluated as much. Therefore, some priority should be provided for tenured faculty over non-tenured faculty. Both sides agreed to consider specific language for discussion at the next meeting.

Article 9 – Administration offered a counter proposal. FUSA offered a counter proposal.
